Subject: International Container Loading Fees

Below please find the 2018 Container Loading, Storage and Documentation Fee Schedule.

Our Distributors continue to have the option to contract the loading and packing of their containers with their preferred freight forwarder. If contracted with a designated forwarder, the cargo is shipped as loose cargo to the declared freight forwarder's warehouse. If you do not designate a freight forwarder, your order is packed and loaded by Kidde per the fee schedule.

FEE SCHEDULE: The standardized fee schedule below is for logistic services performed by Kidde. These services will be invoiced separately from the Distributor's equipment order. The Distributor will receive an invoice the first week of the following month after the shipment. Equipment orders invoiced through a Letter of Credit will be invoiced with Net 30 Terms. Quoted fees include best-in-class packaging materials and processes.

40 foot container Loading Fee: \$995 USD (loading, bracing and blocking material)

20 foot container Loading Fee: \$895 USD (loading, bracing and blocking material)

MODIFICATIONS: In the event of any requested modifications and/or changes initiated by the Distributor after the product has been transferred to the 3rd party warehouse, Distributor shall pay, in addition to the Container Loading Fee above, an additional **\$495 USD** each way (representing the additional freight fee). There will also be additional fees related to changes to already prepared documentation.

STORAGE: The Distributor shall incur a storage charge of **\$30 USD** per pallet per month retroactive to the first day if the product is not picked up within thirty (30) days of scheduled delivery date due to no fault of Kidde. You, as our Distributor, can now authorize Kidde to transfer finished product to a 3rd party warehouse for the purpose of container loading on your behalf. Please be aware that Distributors will be responsible for payment of each container loaded.

CONTAINER LOADING AND STORAGE FEE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is effective as of , _____ 2018, by and between Kidde Fenwal, Inc., d/b/a Kidde Fire Systems ("Kidde") and [Insert name of Distributor] ("Distributor").

WHEREAS, the parties intend this Agreement to apply to all purchases by Distributor after the Effective Date of certain Kidde products that require international shipment by container

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises exchanged in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the parties, it is agreed:

1. SCOPE

This Agreement shall apply to all international container shipments after the Effective Date. Distributor hereby authorizes Kidde to transfer finished product to a 3rd party warehouse for the purpose of container loading on behalf of Distributor. Distributor hereby agrees to pay for said container loading, freight and storage fees as specified in Section 3 below.

2. TERM

The term of this Agreement (the "Term") shall commence on the Effective Date, and shall continue in effect until terminated by either party upon the given of not less than sixty (60) days written notice of intent to terminate.

3. FEE SCHEDULE (subject to change upon written agreement between the parties)

Container Loading Fee: **\$995 USD per 40 ft container** (includes blocking material, bracing and bill of Lading).

In the event of any requested modifications and/or changes after the product has been transferred to the 3rd party warehouse initiated by Distributor, Distributor shall pay, in addition Container Loading Fee above, an additional **\$495 USD** each way representing the additional freight fee. Additionally, Distributor shall incur a storage charge of **\$30 USD** per pallet per month retroactive to the first day if the product is not picked-up within thirty (30) days of scheduled delivery date through no fault of Kidde.

4. PAYMENT

Distributor authorizes Kidde to pre-pay and add container loading, freight and storage fees as agreed in Section 3 to Distributor's open account and Distributor shall pay all open balances pursuant to the agreed to payment terms contained in its account.

5. Shipment, Title and Risk of Loss

For products subject to this Agreement, shipments shall be Ex-Works Origin (Incoterms® 2010) either Kidde Factory, Ashland, Massachusetts or Kidde's 3rd party warehouse. Distributor agrees pays all freight costs in addition to price. Distributor is responsible for addressing lost or damaged shipments with their freight forwarder. Title to all goods sold hereunder and risk of loss or damage thereto shall pass to Distributor upon the latter event to occur; either the request date contained in Kidde's Order Acknowledgement or once Kidde is provided with a confirmed vessel booking from Distributor's Freight Forwarder.

6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS
